



Satellite Navigation - SY9 5EA

The village hall postcode (SY9 5DX) covers a wide area and will bring you into the center of the village near to the church, rather than the hall which is just off the 'main road'. We therefore suggest using the postcode SY9 5EA which will take you to Norbury Primary School, approx 0.25 miles along the 'main road' from the village hall - see map below for more details.

Caution! - The most direct route from Church Stretton is over the Long Mynd but entails using very steep and exposed single track roads - not advisable for less confident drivers or those who suffer from vertigo!

How to find us

Norbury, Bishops Castle, Shropshire, SY9 5DX
(Satellite navigation - please use postcode SY9 5EA)

The Village Hall at Norbury is situated on the outskirts of Norbury village, which is 4.5 miles from the market town of Bishops Castle and approx 8.75 miles from the A49 - the main road linking the county towns of Shrewsbury and Ludlow.

From A49 - Ludlow / Craven Arms going North

After Craven Arms follow the A49 for 1.4 miles turning left at the builders merchants onto the A489 signposted for Newtown and Bishops Castle...

From A49 - Shrewsbury / Church Stretton going South

After the traffic lights at Church Stretton follow the A49 for 2.7 miles, turning right next to the garage at Marshbrook onto the B4370 and over the level crossing. Follow the road for 2.7 miles until it meets the A489. Turn right towards Bishops Castle...

...To avoid the network of narrow single-track lanes and farm traffic (see map below), continue along the A489 until you eventually find the Long Mynd behind you at Plowden. After approx 3.2 miles and past the turning for Bishops Castle on the left, the road bends sharply to the right. Almost immediately after the bend take the unnamed road on the right signposted for Norbury and The Green Caravan Park. Continue for 2.5 miles, taking the second of 2 roads on the left to Norbury village where the entrance to the village hall car park will be just a few yards on your right.

From Bishops Castle

From the A488 going north, take the B4383 on the right signposted for Craven Arms and Church Stretton. Continue for 1 mile, turning left onto the A489 then a quick right onto the unnamed road signposted for Norbury and The Green Caravan Park. See last part of instructions above.

Other routes from Shrewsbury

In addition to the A49 there are two minor / scenic routes from Shrewsbury:

- * A488 (off the A5) - taking you through Pontesbury, Minsterley, the Hope Valley and Lydham.
- * Longden Road (off the Roman Road near Shrewsbury cemetery) - taking you over the hills through Longden, Pulverbatch and Ratlinghope.
